Missions of Love has partnered with *Feed My Starving Children* to meet the needs of school children in Northwest Haiti. Through this program we can feed a child for 5 cents a day. Nowhere else can a nickel go so far.

This program is an excellent opportunity for your children to reach out and help a hungry school child in Haiti.



Feed My Starving Children is a Christian, non-profit organization. In 1987 they launched a program to begin the task of developing a meal containing all the daily-required nutrients to feed the starving children of the world. They developed a process where a meal is packaged in small pouches. Each meal contains rice, soy nuggets, vitamins, minerals, chicken flavoring and dehydrated vegetables. FMSC then partner with organizations like MOL that have a history and people “on the ground” in third world countries, which distribute it and administer the program.

These highly nutritious meals have won rave reviews. While the formula was designed to save the lives of severely malnourished children, the ingredients also improve the health, growth and physical well-being of children who are no longer in immediate danger of starvation.

Please present this to your Vacation Bible School or Sunday School Classes. If each child could bring five cents a day for this program it would fulfill a great need to help this program flourish. We feel this is God’s answer to many ongoing prayers for the Haitian Children.
